

Who represents poor people?

Population:

- the owner of a field of 1-3 ha- subsistence agriculture;
- a person who has a monthly income up to 1500 lei per member;
- people who are able to work but unemployed;

Constrains

- The lack of access to accessible financial resources;
- The lack of economical infrastructure;
- The lack of knowledge and limited access to information;
- Limited access to market for small farmers;
- The lack of jobs with a decent wage;
- Limited access to stat agriculture grants;

Opportunities

- Financial resources for medium and long term with low interest, including grants;
- Agricultural activity launch with added value;
- Professional teaching and financial education;
- Participation to courses for entrepreneurs and business launch;
- Employment;
- Access to economic infrastructure (irigation, road);

Support Strategies of IFAD

- **Direct**

- Support for economical infrastructure development creation;
- Access to cheap financial resources, including through SCA;
- Continuous support of programmes for women and youth;
- Support for start-up:
 - Practical instruction;
 - Access to resources, including Grant;
 - Post-credit consulting and assistance;
 - Support for credit guarantee up to 100%;
- Development of type-company for cluster advance and cooperation for new markets attend;
- Tuition;

- **Indirect**

- Producers group stimulation;
- Market access support through value chain development;
- Credit line and investments for medium enterprises, with monitorization of created working places;
- Support of agricultural educational centres for practical agricultural programmes development;
- Support of the domains with increased added value and post-harvest, that generates new working place;
